

Calibrating learners in a group

To get an insight into how individuals in the class prefer to learn:

- **V:** walk back and forth in front of the class. Those who follow you with their eyes have a visual preference for learning.



- **A:** the few auditory learners in your class do not establish much eye contact while learning. The auditory learner is usually the last to finish exams and gets good results. This is probably due to the fact that s/he spends more time and effort retrieving information from memory than the visual learner.



- **K:** the kinaesthetic learner is physically active and can easily get bored having to sit still for a long time. He is thus often perceived as a troublemaker by teachers.
