A basic question in dealing with groups is:

"How can I interpret the constant feedback I am receiving from the group?"

- In the 'Perception' branch we can experience just how much we miss (miscalibrate) through our naturally faulty perception.
- The 'Senses' branch calls for a return to the senses. It is through these that we can learn to improve calibration and thus come to interpret group feedback correctly.
- The 'References' lead us to the discussion of just how much we can trust our intuition and an extreme example of perception: that of an autistic boy.
